LifeSherpa Uses at Legacy Farms



Timekeeping

Apprentices enter their hours at the end of each workday to streamline timekeeping for payroll.



Daily Reflections

Apprentices use a garden workday questionnaire to reflect on tasks completed, mindfulness reflections, and identification of tasks to be completed during their next workday.



Work Resources

Videos, links, and text can be found in a resources tile for apprentices to access "how to" videos for garden skills and guided mindfulness practices.



Evaluation Tracking

Daily reflections, self-assessments for skills tracking, and self-assessment for self-awareness are utilized by the evaluation team to track progress of skills and self-growth in the program.

Legacy Farms Evaluation Tracking with LifeSherpa

Legacy Farms has three areas of assessment and LifeSherpa makes it possible to do daily and quarterly data capture direct from apprentices:



Personal Development

This is the most essential and complex area of tracking and research since it is central to the Legacy Farms program and focused on development of the self which is less quantifiable.

1. **Quarterly Seasonal Reviews** that give information on frequency of mindfulness practice at that stage
2. **Daily Reflections** highlight completed tasks and prioritizing future work to cultivate initiative, discernment, and leadership qualities
3. **SAOQ (Self-Awareness Outcomes Questionnaire)** completed pre-program and quarterly to assess four areas of self-awareness
4. **Semi-structured interviews** collected into Otter transcription, combined with daily mindfulness responses from LifeSherpa



Apprenticeship Skills Training / "Train to Work"

Legacy Farms tracks the development of independent work skills in 18 garden tasks ranging from early educational training tasks to garden apprenticeship responsibilities to entrepreneurial apprenticeship and/or mentor-in-training advancement. Quarterly data collection tracks each apprentice's status (full assistance to independence).

1. **LifeSherpa:** Apprentices self-assess on each skill, quarterly
2. **Mentor report:** Skills assessment, quarterly



7-Step Program

Starting with interviews and work agreements, followed by on-the-job training, timekeeping, performance reviews, resume building, and job references, we track each apprentice through these seven steps. During the first year, apprentices move sequentially through each step. If they return for a second year, they develop deeper skills in each area.

1. **LifeSherpa:** Apprentices complete Seasonal Review, a self-report of status through the 7 Step process
2. **Mentor report:** Seasonal review, quarterly notes status on each step
